

Mystery Stamping

Cardstock/Paper:

- **Patterned Paper/Designer Series Paper:** 6.5cm x 11.5cm (vertical)
- **Coloured cardstock** that coordinates with the DSP: 21cm x 14.85cm, scored at 10.5cm
- **Cardstock Layer** – same colour as card base: 10cm x 14.3cm
- **Coloured Cardstock** – coordinates with your DSP, but a contrasting colour to your card base. The similar height as your circle and 9cm long. Eg. 7cm x 9cm
- **Die-cut or Punched Circle** approx. 7cm in diameter (I used Spotlight on Nature Dies). I die cut it on Basic White cardstock. Choose a cardstock colour that complements your DSP but is different to the 7cm x 9cm piece.
- **Basic White Cardstock** for sentiment (approx. 1.5cm x 5cm) and a piece 10cm x 14.3cm for the card insert.

Stamps, Tools & More:

- **Main Image** for the inside the circle – It can be stamped straight onto the circle. Or you can stamp and fussy cut out/punch/die-cut or it could be a die-cut image. If it stamped and needs colouring, please colour ahead of time
- **Background Stamp** – could be flowers, stars, pattern, etc
- **Sentiment Stamp** - Not too big approx. It needs to fit on a small strip. Approx. 1.5cm x 5cm
- **Ink** for stamping the background – VersaMark or ink that is the same colour as your 7cm x 9cm piece of cardstock.
- Ink for stamping your sentiment and your main image
- **Embossing Folder** of your choice & Emboss & Die Cutting Machine
- **Ribbon or Twine and Embellishments**
- **Paper Snips Scissors**
- **Adhesives** including Stampin' Dimensionals

INSTRUCTIONS:

Clue 1:

Emboss the 10cm x 14.3cm piece of coloured cardstock with an embossing folder of your choice. Adhere it to the card front.

Clue 2:

With the 6.5cm x 11.5cm piece of patterned paper (vertical), cut a small banner shape at the bottom and adhere onto the middle of your card front.

Clue 3:

Stamp a background stamp around the edge of the 7cm x 9cm horizontal piece of coloured cardstock with VersaMark ink, or ink the same colour the cardstock.

Clue 4:

Adhere the stamped coloured cardstock piece onto the card front (horizontal) in the middle, but slightly more towards the top. You should be able to see some of the patterned paper at the top, but slightly more at the bottom.

Clue 5:

Stamp your main image in the circle or on a scrap piece of cardstock. If it is on a scrap piece of cardstock, cut it out with paper snips, a punch or die. If it is cut out, adhere your main stamped/die-cut piece to the circle with Stampin' Dimensionals.

Clue 6:

Adhere the circle to the centre of the 7cm x 9cm piece with Stampin' Dimensionals.

Clue 7:

Stamp a sentiment and fussy cut it out. Adhere it to the towards the bottom right of the circle, just below it.

Clue 8:

Tie a bow with ribbon or twine and adhere to the left-side of the sentiment.

Clue 9:

Add some embellishments.

Clue 10:

If you wish, stamp something on the 10cm x 14.3cm piece of Basic White cardstock and adhere inside your card.
